

THINGS TO PACK...

WHAT TO BRING:

- L Bible
- L Pen/pencil for taking notes (notebooks provided)
- L Towels for pool and personal use (towels and washcloths ARE NOT PROVIDED by Trinity Pines)
- L Appropriate play clothes - walking shorts are permitted in evening service (no spaghetti straps or short shorts)
- L Enough clothes for TWO CHANGES per day
- L Swimsuit suitable for a Christian Camp (one-piece for girls and trunks for boys)
- L Shoes suitable for outdoor activities (bring at least 2 pair, if it rains there will be mud. FLIP FLOPS DON'T COUNT)
- L Costume to wear at our DISCO! (see following page)
- L Insect repellent (there are LOTS of fire ants and mosquitoes) AND sun block (sunburns are not fun)
- L Medication form (if necessary)
- L Medical release forms
- L Personal hygiene items
- L Flashlight

OPTIONAL:

- L Cash - for snack bar and to purchase souvenirs from camp store & the Christian Illusionist, Jonathan Curtis
- L Calling Card to call home or directions on how to make a collect call
- L Camera (if you bring a disposable camera, make sure your name is on it!)
- L Fishing equipment
- L Hat (mark your name on it)
- L Your own pillow

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- L Cell Phones or other non-medical electronic devices
- L Laser pointers, radios, tape players, CD players, MP3 or IPOD players, TV or hand-held video games
- L Fireworks, firearms or any kind of weapon
- L Shaving cream (except for shaving)
- L Water balloons or water guns
- L Tobacco (IN ANY FORM)
- L Drugs/controlled substances (except as prescribed by physician accompanied by the medication form)
- L Expensive personal belongings (jewelry, expensive cameras, cell phones, etc.)
- L Bedding/sleeping bags - Trinity Pines provides sheets, pillow and pillow cases.
- L ANYTHING THAT SHOULDN'T BE AT CAMP...if you have to ask - it is probably NOT OK!
